

Columbia Place Mall

Welcome to Columbia Place Mall. We strive to provide an enjoyable and safe shopping environment for you, your family and our employees. Columbia Place Mall, including the parking area, is **PRIVATE PROPERTY**. This Code of conduct is in effect at all times 24/7. Persons violating this code of conduct will be asked to leave Columbia Place Mall property. Those who continue to violate this Code of Conduct will be subject to arrest.

Code of Conduct

The following activities are prohibited on mall property:

1. Physically or verbally threatening any person, fighting, annoying others through noisy or boisterous activities or by unnecessary staring, follows another person through the Center, using sexually explicit language or conduct, creating a disturbance in any other way which is disruptive or dangerous to the Center's patrons or its commercial function. Yelling, screaming, singing, playing musical instruments, radios, tape players, CD players, MP3's, or other sound amplification devices, communicating in a manner which creates noise of sufficient volume to impinge on the hearing or peace of the general public.
2. Possession of any item that could be used as a weapon, including, but not limited to: firearms, explosives, fireworks, clubs or sticks, chemical dispensing devices, knives, or any other object(s) that may be used in any way to inflict bodily injury on another person.
3. Use of physical force, obscene language, obscene gestures, or any racial, religious or ethnic slurs which are likely to create a disturbance or impinge on the hearing or peace of others.
4. Wearing apparel or signifying in a manner which is likely to provoke a disturbance or embroil other groups or the general public in open conflict. You must be fully clothed while at the center and clothing must adequately cover the body. Clothing or any attire must not be gang related such as clothing suggesting slangs, slogans, or symbols. Clothing cannot obscure the face and clothing designed with an attached hood must be worn down (off the head) while inside the mall. Underclothing cannot be exposed.
5. No loitering, assembling for the purpose of disturbing the public, peace, or committing any unlawful act or engaging in any offensive behavior.
6. Running, skating, rollerblading, skateboarding, riding a bicycle, scooter, 2 wheel motorized drifting boards, or engaging in activities which obstruct or interfere with the free flow of pedestrian traffic or with patrons' view of windows and other tenant displays.
7. Engaging in any non-commercial expressive activity without complying with the Center's rules for such activity.
8. Engaging in any activity not sponsored and/or conducted by the Center and/or an enterprise(s) engaged in business at the Center, other than certain qualified labor activity. This includes, without limitation, solicitation of money or other contributions or donations, or distribution of commercial advertising or promotional material of any kind, or offering samples of items which are sold, available for or available in exchange for a donation or contribution.
9. Defacing, damaging or destroying any real or personal property constituting part of, or located in or on the Center and belonging to the Center, its patrons or its tenants, including writing, spraying, scratching or otherwise affixing graffiti on such property. Sitting on, standing on, hanging from, or putting feet on walls, windows, railings, landscaping, columns, partitions, chairs, benches, trash receptacles, or any other decorative feature or device not intended for that purpose.
10. Creating litter, throwing, discarding or depositing any paper, glass or other matter of any kind at the Center, except in designated trash receptacles. Rummaging through or removing items from the trash receptacles is prohibited.
11. Having animals at the Center, other than service animals providing assistance to disabled patrons or service animals in training in the company of their trainer.
12. Photographing or videotaping any individual or entity on the Center's property without Mall Management and the subject's consent.
13. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited except in businesses licensed to sell and allow consumption. Being intoxicated, or impaired, and/or possessing illegal drugs are prohibited.
14. Parking on property is prohibited after Mall closing. Parking in non-designated parking areas, parking and/or standing in fire lanes or other no parking areas is prohibited. Unauthorized vehicles may be towed at owner's expense.
15. Using a laser pointer or a device generating any light beam, air wave, or sound wave even if it is directed at a person with their consent, or any other use therefore.
16. Smoking (including any type of electronic cigarettes) is ONLY allowed in designated smoking areas, which are at least 25 feet away from any entrance.
